## IN 2016 OUR DONORS FUNDED THE FOLLOWING GRANTS

#### **#16** New Signage

Out dated and unattractive signs were redesigned and erected, from billboards and roadside directional signs to office and station identification and portable banners, to increase visibility and draw additional visitors.

#### #18 Safety

Safety and emergency procedures are the focus of this grant, which covers GPS units, walkie talkies, first aid equipment, and immobilization and extraction equipment.

#### **#20 Monteverde Arenal Bioregion Initiative**

The cosorganization and development of the new Monteverde Arenal Bioregion Initiative and conference. It's goal is to create a common mission for the actions and initiatives in the region. This is the third annual MABI Conference

#### **#17 Environmental Education**



#### **#19 Viewing Platform**

The viewing platform overlooking the gorgeous waterfall at Pocosol was being damaged by moisture and insects. This helped replace that with a galvanized steel structure that is both safe and beautiful.
